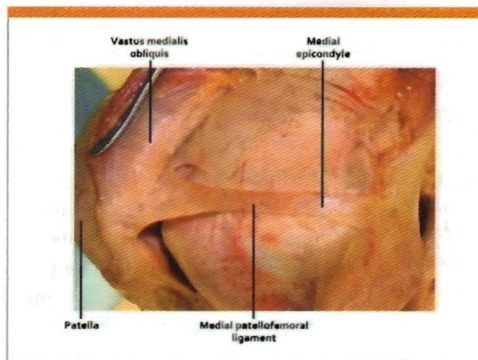

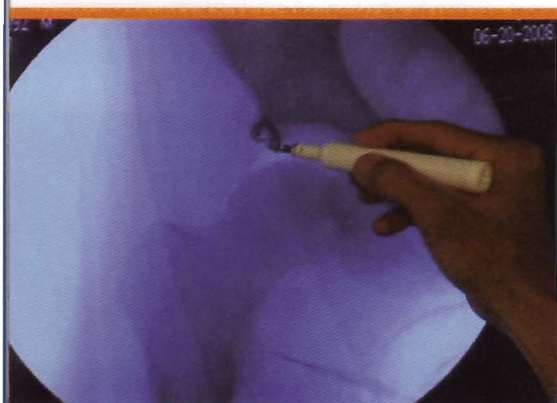


The Key to the Knee: A Layer-by-Layer Video Demonstration of Medial and Anterior Anatomy
